Natural Bridge Elementary School, located at 1650 NE 141 Street in North Miami, Florida, 33181, is dedicated to the goal of facilitating the highest quality education possible for every student in our school. We service a multicultural community consisting of 59 percent Black, 32 percent White, 27 percent Hispanic, 2 percent Asian, 0.5 percent American Indian, and 2 percent Multiracial. Our school's student population consists of 650 students in grades Pre-K to 5, with 85 percent Black Non-Hispanic, 1 percent White Non-Hispanic, 13 percent Hispanic, and 1 percent Asian/Indian/ Multiracial. Eighteen percent of our population includes students with disabilities, and 28 percent are students who are learning English as a second language. The number of students enrolled at Natural Bridge Elementary has increased approximately thirty students a year for the past three years. Our school staff demographics consists of 53 percent Black, 28 percent White, 18 percent Hispanic, and 1 percent Other. At Natural Bridge Elementary, we believe that all students will meet their academic potential when given effective academic opportunities delivered in a stimulating and challenging learning environment. Therefore, we utilize numerous programs, such as the YMCA program that provides excellent after school care. Our students also engage in after school clubs and activities, such as the Garden Club, Art Club, and Chess Club. A small group of our students also participate in the prestigious Miami Choral Academy, a choral program sponsored by Seraphic Fire. Moreover, we are in the beginning stages of implementing the Extended Foreign Language (EFL) program beginning at the kindergarten level with the end result of a fully implemented school wide bilingual program. Additionally, four of our teachers are National Board Certified. The strategies we use address the needs of our multicultural/multi-ethnic students as we help them to reach their academic potential.

More than 50 percent of our students are from a home where English is a second language. Consequently, parents are not familiar with the American educational system and many are not proficient in English. This presents a barrier toward parental involvement and parent participation in the educational process. We offer parent meetings and workshops on an ongoing basis to address this challenge.

Furthermore, our principal Frank V. MacBride, Jr. was a North Region Principal of the Year finalist for the 2014-2015 school year.
